

**TREASURER'S REPORT
MURRAMARANG COMMUNITY GARDEN
AGM 9 AUGUST 14**

At the end of the financial year we has 69 financial members.

Financially we have had a very successful year. From having no funds in the bank in November we had an adjusted balance at the bank at the end of the financial year of \$7617.92. (This includes undeposited cheques + a deposit)

We were fortunate in having the Bangalay Growers Group give our garden \$2207.22 + an un-registered trailer. The trailer has since been registered. Many thanks to those who took part in the fundraising at the cake stall held at the Bawley shops in December, at the Kioloa Fair in January and at the Easter Fair. In total we raised \$6350.30 from fundraising with expenditure of \$722.82 to be deducted from the total (\$5627.48). We raised \$544.85 from sale of produce during the year which includes the sale of our garlic crop.

Our major expenditure has been on the 'Turnip'. So far has been \$5477 for the Clivus Multrum + \$1229.42 for construction incidentals. (\$6706.42) We purchased one load of soil \$1785.14 and one bundle of sleepers \$794.15. Other expenditure has been for incidentals.

The accounts are available here for anyone to peruse should they wish.

It has been my pleasure to have acted in the position of treasurer since 2011 and I am now stepping aside to allow another person to fill the post. Change is good.

My thanks to all the committee members and the garden members with whom I have enjoyed working, and with who I will continue to work, to make the garden a great place to come and enjoy growing things and companionship. I wish the new committee all the best and look forward to a renewed vigour in the garden environment.

I would also like to submit my resignation as public officer, effective immediately.
